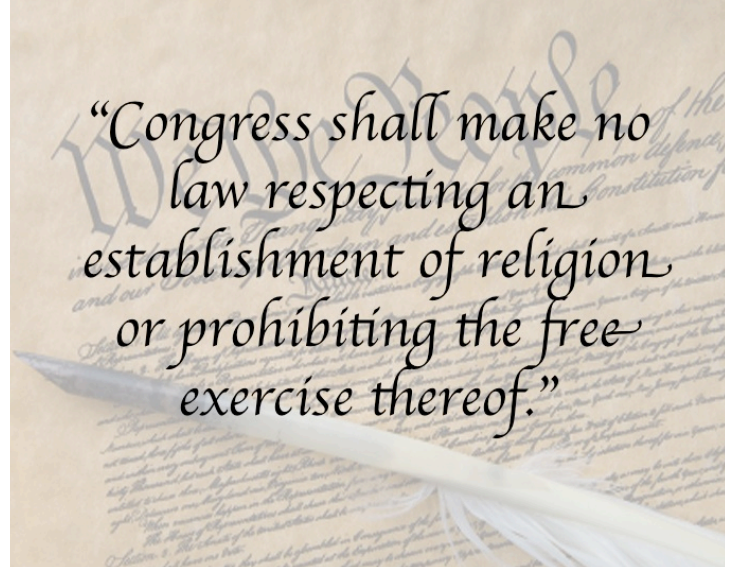
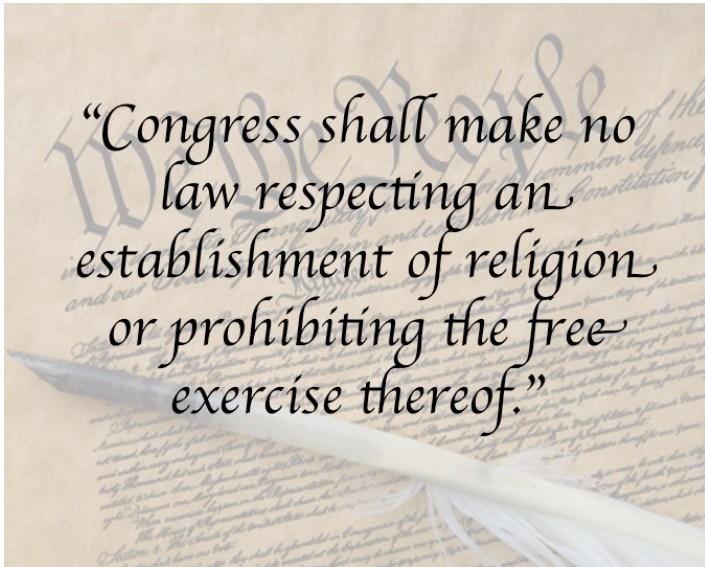


First Amendment vs. First Amendment
